- A statement relating to your personal circumstances. Your statement should include details of any personal, financial, employment or other commitments which you may have in the United Kingdom/your country of residence and which will induce your return to that country. Evidence of your personal circumstances should be provided wherever possible (eg. a letter from your employer, a mortgage statement) You should also provide us with details of your intentions after your visit to Australia.
