### **CABINS**

There are 3 double cabins on E Deck for passenger use, all outside (though the views can be obstructed by containers), with private shower/wc and refrigerator. The **Owner's** Cabin is about 26 square metres in area, carpeted, with twin beds (110 cm); the **Super Cargo** and **2**<sup>nd</sup> **Officer** cabins are 22 square metres without carpets and double beds (140 cm).

## **AGE LIMIT**

The vessels do not carry doctors, therefore we regret that no-one aged over 79 years can be accepted as a passenger. All passengers require a medical certificate, but additionally anyone between 75 and 79 inclusive will be asked to have the company's medical certificate completed by their doctor at the time of booking as well as another within 30 days of departure.

## **VISAS and VACCINATIONS**

**Non-US** citizens **MUST** be in possession of a **US** visa. The US visa waiver scheme does NOT apply to passengers on these vessels. Also required is an Australian visa (Electronic Travel Authority).

Non-New Zealand passengers travelling one way to Auckland must be in possession of an onward ticket from New Zealand.

A yellow fever vaccination is needed for the Panama Canal – further details will be given when booking.
