



# Teaching in Western Australia

**Western Australia (WA) is Australia's biggest state – if you are a primary or secondary school teacher it can offer you some big employment opportunities and an exciting Aussie lifestyle.**

The Department of Education and Training is now sponsoring teachers (minimum of four years of full-time university training including a minimum of one year of teacher training) to work in government schools in country areas in WA on a three year contract (on a Business Sub Class 457 Visa ).

Secondary school teachers are needed in these subject areas:

- Mathematics
- Science (Physics and Chemistry)
- English
- Design and Technology
- Home Economics
- Modern Foreign Languages (Indonesian and Japanese).

**Primary school teachers are needed in country areas, to start in 2010.**

## SALARIES

Teacher salaries range from \$48,425 to \$69,132 a year, undertaking professional development can increase this to \$72,844. There are additional allowances when working in country schools. You will also receive 9 per cent employer contributions to your pension/superannuation fund.

## PERMANENT RESIDENCY

After two years of satisfactory service in a country school you may be eligible to be nominated for permanent residency. If you are interested in this option you should note that you must be under 45 years of age at the time of nomination (ie. after two years of teaching in WA).
